

Event Safety

With the promulgation of the Safety at Sports and Recreational Events Act, No 2 of 2010, it is now compulsory for the organisers of all events to comply with this legislation. This course will enable organisations to put plans in place that will ensure:

- Public safety at all major events categories;
- Proper pre-planning and compliance with safety legislation and policies;
- Role-players working at events that understand each other's duties and functions in terms of events safety;
- Ability to facilitate a risk assessment process for an event; and
- Ability to draw up an event safety plan.
